*New Hires will be paid the Federal minimum wage of \$8.00, which was increased for NYS employees as of 5/22/14 (Admin. payroll) and 5/29/14 (Instit. payroll). On and after 12/31/14 the minimum wage will increase to \$8.75 per hour, and on and after 12/31/15, the minimum wage will increase to \$9.00, per Budget Bulletin G-1035. Returning employees may be paid a different rate (but not less than the minimum wage), subject to the approval of the Division of Budget.
