**SUBJECT: Increased Minimum Wage for State Seasonal and Other Non-Statutory Positions Paid on an Hourly Basis**

Chapter 57 of the Laws of 2013 increased New York State's minimum wage for those employed in non-governmental positions. The Director of the Budget establishes the rate of pay for State seasonal and other non-statutory positions paid on an hourly basis.

Consistent with the intent of Chapter 57, this bulletin increases the minimum wage paid to seasonal and other non-statutory positions from the current rate of \$7.25 per hour to:

- \$8.00 per hour on May 22, 2014, for positions on the Administrative payroll and May 29, 2014, for positions on the Institutional payroll;
- \$8.75 per hour on and after December 31, 2014; and
- \$9.00 per hour on and after December 31, 2015.

To effectuate these increases effective on the dates listed above, agencies should process compensation adjustments in NYSTEP and pay rate changes in PAYSERV.

For more detailed information on the application of the minimum wage increases to union-represented seasonal employees, please refer to appropriate collective bargaining agreements.
