AN ACT

to amend chapter 53 of the laws of
2008 making appropriations for the
support of government

The People of the State of New
York, represented in Senate and
Assembly, do enact as follows:

1) Single House Bill (introduced and printed separately in either or both houses). Uni-Bill (introduced simultaneously in both houses and printed as one bill. Senate and Assembly introducer sign the same copy of the bill).

2) Circle names of co-sponsors and return to introduction clerk with 2 signed copies of bill and 4 copies of memorandum in support (single house); or 4 signed copies of bill and 8 copies of memorandum in support (uni-bill).

1 Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 53 of the laws of 2008, enacting the
 2 education, labor and family assistance budget, as amended by section 3
 3 of chapter 496 of the laws of 2008, is amended by repealing the items
 4 hereinbelow set forth in brackets and by adding to such section the
 5 other items underscored in this section.
